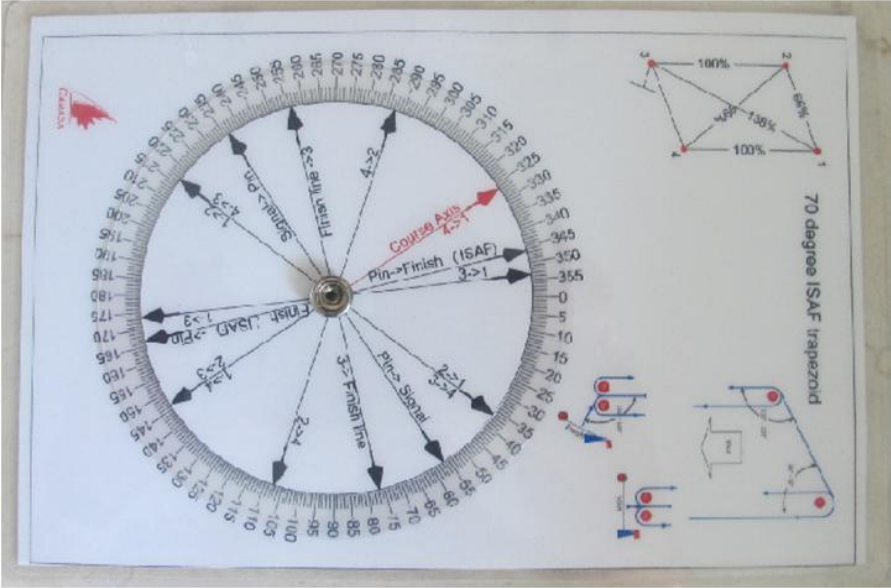
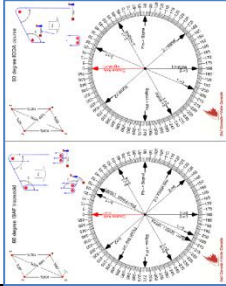


Instructions to make a mark laying dial (This makes two)

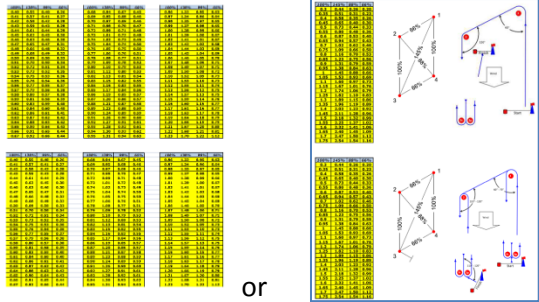


1. Print two copies of the selected front course mark laying dial on thicker paper stock. I used 110 lbs paper stocked by Staples. Because the centre gets punched waterproof paper might also work.



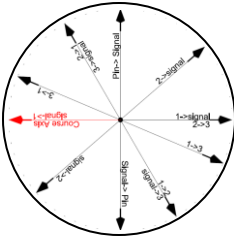

2. Print the back side on one of the matching front mark laying dials



or

3. Cut the compass dials out of one of the front laying dial sheets.



4. Laminate the cut out compass dials using 5mil heatseal lamination

Trim the lamination plastic about $\frac{1}{4}$ beyond the circle to keep it water tight.

5. Laminate the mark laying dials using 10 mil heatseal lamination

6. Mount the compass dials to the mark laying dial backgrounds using a snap buttons.
