

## Racing Rules of Sailing

### Title to Part 7 and Rule 91(b)

A submission from the Chairman of the Racing Rules Committee

#### Purpose or Objective

Minor wording changes made for consistency.

#### Proposal

Change the title to Part 7 as follows:

## **PART 7**

---

## **EVENT ~~RACE~~ ORGANIZATION**

Change rule 91(b) as follows:

- (b) an international jury appointed by the organizing authority or as prescribed in the World Sailing Regulations. It shall be composed as required by rule N1 and have the authority and responsibilities stated in rule N2. A national authority may prescribe that its approval is required for the appointment of international juries for **events** ~~aces~~ within its jurisdiction, except World Sailing events or when international juries are appointed by World Sailing under rule 89.2(c); or

#### Current Position

As above.

#### Reasons

1. The rules in Part 7 apply to all aspects of an event and not just to the race or races that may be conducted during the event.
  2. International juries are appointed for an event, not just for the races in the event. The jury assumes all protest committee duties during the event, including dealing with issues that may arise before the first race, between races and after the last race.
