






Changes to the course will be made by laying a new Mark 1.

•RRS 33 and Race Signals are changed as follows:

•Flag C and a coloured flag or board means ‘The windward mark has been moved or replaced. Sail to a mark the same colour as the flag or board.’

•When a change of course after starting only affects some matches these will be designated by the appropriate numeral pennant.

•When a change of course is made for the first leg, the signal will be displayed from the race committee starting boat with the preparatory signal for each match affected. The preparatory signal will be followed by a series of repetitive sound signals.
