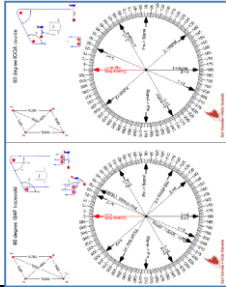
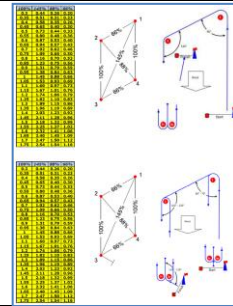


# Instructions to make a mark laying dial (This makes two)

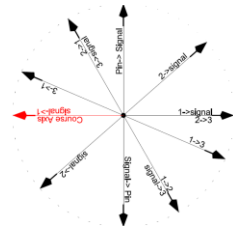
1. Print two copies of the selected front course mark laying dial on thicker paper stock. I use 110 lbs paper stocked by Staples. [http://www.staples.com/Staples-Card-Stock-8-1-2-inch-x-11-inch-White-250/product\\_490887](http://www.staples.com/Staples-Card-Stock-8-1-2-inch-x-11-inch-White-250/product_490887)



2. Print the back side on one of the mark laying dials



3. Cut the compass dials out of the other mark laying dial sheet



4. Laminate the cut out compass dials using 5mil heatseal lamination

5. Laminate the mark laying dials using 10 mil heatseal lamination

6. Mount the compass dials to the mark laying dial background using a snap buttons.
